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New CBP Forced Labor Portal Now Live

U.S. Customs and Border Protection has officially launched its Forced Labor Portal, which will become a mandatory requirement starting January 21, 2026 for specific forced labor–related review submissions.

Importers must use the portal to submit:

Withhold Release Order (WRO) / Finding admissibility reviews

Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA) applicability reviews

UFLPA exception requests

Countering America's Adversaries Through Sanctions Act (CAATSA) exception requests
