

Instructions for Completion of the Power of Attorney

Page 1 – Cross outs, erasures or white-out are not allowed by Customs

See correlating numbers on the Power of Attorney

- 1) Check the box for the appropriate type of organization
- 2) Enter your company's EIN/IRS Number (or Social Security Number if you are an individual).
- 3) Enter your company's full legal name without abbreviations
- 4) Enter type of company such as; Corporation, LLC, Partnership, or Sole Proprietorship
- 5) Enter the state in which your company was incorporated. If not incorporated, then enter the state in which you are authorized to conduct business
- 6) Enter the current address of your principal place of business or residence (if an individual)
- 7) Enter your company's full and legal name, just as it is listed in blank # 3 & 4
- 8) An OFFICER of the corporation must sign the Power of Attorney
- 9) Enter the title of the person signing in Blank #8. Note that this must be an OFFICER of the company
- 10) Enter the date the Power of Attorney was signed
- 11) Witness required for sole proprietor or if only one corporate officer exists

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If an Individual or Partnership, complete section as directed.

If a Corporation, please complete Corporate Certification bearing in mind that another Corporate Officer must sign certification and that Corporate Officer shall be different from the one who has signed page 1.

Note:

If there is only one Corporate Officer in the company, this shall be noted on Page 2 close in proximity to the Corporate Certification section.

Make, endorse, sign, declare, or swear to any customs entry, withdrawal, declaration, certificate, bill of lading, carnet or any other documents required
by law or regulation in connection with the importation, exportation, transportation, of any merchandise in or through the customs territory, shipped or
consigned by or to said grantor;
Perform any act or condition, which may be required by law or regulation in connection with such merchandise deliverable to said grantor; to receive any
merchandise;

Make endorsements on bills of lading conferring authority to transfer title; make entry or collect drawback; and to make, sign, declare, or swear to any
statement or certificate required by law or regulation for drawback purposes, regardless of whether such document is intended for filing with Customs;

Sign, seal, and deliver for and as the act of said grantor any bond required by law or regulation in connection with the entry or withdrawal of imported
merchandise or merchandise exported with or without benefit of drawback, or in connection with the entry, clearance, lading, unlading or navigation of
any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor, and any and all bonds which may be voluntarily given and accepted under
applicable laws and regulations, consignee's and owner's declarations provided for in section 485, Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, or affidavits or
statements in connection with the entry of merchandise;

Sign and swear to any document and to perform any act that may be necessary or required by law or regulation in connection with the entering, clearing,
lading, unlading, or operation of any vessel or other means of conveyance owned or operated by said grantor;
Authorize other Customs Brokers duly licensed within the territory to act as grantor's agent; to receive, endorse and collect checks issued for Customs
duty refunds in grantor's name drawn on the Treasurer of the United States; if the grantor is a nonresident of the United States, to accept service of
process on behalf of the grantor;
And generally to transact Customs business, including filing of claims or protests under section 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930, or pursuant to other laws of
the territories, in which said grantor is or may be concerned or interested and which may properly be transacted or performed by an agent and attorney;

Giving to said agent and attorney full power and authority to do anything whatever requisite and necessary to be done in the premises as fully as said
grantor could do if present and acting, hereby ratifying and confirming all that the said agent and attorney shall lawfully do by virtue of these presents;
This power of attorney to remain full force and effect until revocation in writing is duly given to and received by grantee (if the donor of this power of
attorney is a partnership, the said power shall in no case have any force or effect in the United States after the expiration 2 years from the dates of its
execution);
Appointment as Forwarding Agent: Grantor authorizes the above Grantee to act within the territory as lawful agent and sign or endorse export
documents (i.e., commercial invoices, bill of lading, insurance certificates, drafts and any other document) necessary for the completion of an export on
grantor's behalf as may be required under law and regulation in the territory and to appoint forwarding agents on grantor's behalf;

governing all transactions between the Parties. If the Grantor is a Limited Liability Company, the signatory certifies that he/she has full
authority to execute this power of the Grantor.
