

**February 8, 2021****YANTIAN TERMINAL TO TEMPORARILY SUSPEND CONTAINER RECEIVING OPERATIONS**

Since February 3rd there has been a queue of vehicles outside the port of Yantian, that include a surge of containers being delivered for outbound cargo. As the peak period hit a week earlier than expected, the terminal activity in Yantian has experienced overwhelming congestion that has caused gridlock. The terminal is already storing nearly 300,000 TEU (twenty-foot equivalent unit) containers, a record amount ever in the history of the port complex.

In order to alleviate severe traffic congestion in the Yantian port area and minimize disturbance to local residences and businesses, the terminal has announced it will suspend receiving export containers that have an estimated departure date of February 16th or later. This will be in effect starting February 9th thru February 11th and will allow the terminal to focus on the immediate container cutoffs for vessel departures up to February 15th. Terminal operations are then expected to resume to normal on February 12th.

We will keep you updated should this timeline change.
